

## Types of Foreign Assistance



### Summary on the Foreign Assistance contracted in 2022

- Total Foreign Aid (grants and soft loans) committed to Jordan in 2022 reached US\$ (4.4) billion, including regular grants, soft loans, and grants to support the Jordan Response Plan to the Syrian crisis.
- This assistance came as a result of the efforts of His Majesty King Abdullah II ibn Al Hussein with brotherly and friendly countries and organizations, and to support the reforms that Jordan is implementing at different fronts, in addition to the understanding of international and donor agencies of Jordan's urgent development needs and the size of the challenges and burdens the country faces in various sectors and thus importance of maintaining the level of services provided to citizens, especially in light of the already limited resources
- The Total Foreign Aid is broken down as follows:
  - Regular grants reached about US\$ (1.66) billion, of which US\$ (1.12) billion as budget support or sectoral budget support, while the rest was committed for development projects.
  - Ontracted concessional loans reached about US\$ (2) billion, of which US\$ (1.47) billion as budget support or sectoral budget support.

- Support to the Jordan Response Plan to the Syrian crisis (JRP) reached about US\$ (760) million representing (33.4%) of required JRP funding estimated at US\$2.28 billion for 2022:

- The sectoral distribution of the Total Foreign Aid is is shown as follows: Budget Support (41.2%); Water and Sanitation Sector (14.4%); Agriculture and Food Security Sector (13.2%); Social Protection Sector (11.7%); Education Sector (4.7%); Economic Development Sector (4.7%); Employment, Vocational Training and Livelihoods Sector (3.1%); and other Sectors (7%).
- Institutional and Capacity Building Support. Through the Support to the Implementation of the EU-Jordan Partnership Priorities, grants were provided to implement twinning projects with the aim to develop the technical and institutional capacities of Public institutions in cooperation with counterpart institutions in the EU Member States, in accordance with best practices. In 2022, two twinning projects were launched, first for the Department of Statistics and the second for the Royal Department for Environmental Protection and Tourism/Directorate of Public Security supported by the EU funded project "Support to the Implementation of the EU-Jordan Partnership Priorities".


- Cultural and Scientific Cooperation. With the aim of strengthening the cultural and scientific cooperation and relations with various countries, MOPIC has worked over 2022 to conclude agreement for scientific and cultural cooperation programs in the fields of (education, higher education, culture, arts, tourism, antiquities, social development, media, communication, sports and youth) with South Korea, Bulgaria, Greece, Cyprus and China, which will be signed during 2023. This is in addition to signing a modified protocol for the scientific and cultural cooperation program with Romania, and of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and the University of North Georgia to train teachers on modern methods of teaching English language.
- In area of **training**, a number of training programs were provided in 2022 in the fields of Water, energy, trade and investment, tourism, transport, health, public finance, environment and sustainable development, legislation, creativity and innovation, small and medium enterprises, cybersecurity and digital transformation, smart cities, social affairs and employment, education and vocational and technical training, agricultural, public-private partnership, risk and disaster management, empowerment of people with special needs. These programs were offered by Japan,

- South Korea, the Netherlands, India, Thailand, Singapore, and the Arab Planning Institute in Kuwait. More than (450) employees from various ministries and public institutions have benefited from these programs.
- In addition, around 100 postgraduate **scholarships**, that were made available by China, Japan, South Korea, Thailand and the Netherlands, were published and circulated through the Civil Service Bureau and the Universities. A number of public officials and students were enrolled into these scholarships through a competitive based approach.
